It's on again for 2011. Malaysian Sepang Moto GP on the weekend 21st - 24th October....organised and supported by us exclusively to give you the time of your life (just look at the faces on last year's travellers!).



This trip leaves Perth early Friday morning (just after midnight Thursday night), arriving at KL in time to check into the Corus Hotel before lunch. The rest of the day is for you to relax and get to know the place. Friday night is free to dine, party or explore the wonders that Malaysia has to offer. Saturday and Sunday are race days, however, some like to shop on Saturday instead....up to you. Saturday and Sunday evenings are full on if that's what you want, or go your own pace...again, up to you. Monday, the flight leaves KL about 9 am to return to Perth about 4ish that arvo. The trip costs \$1,790 per person on a twin-share basis, and includes return airfares, 3 nights at the Corus Hotel (4-star & includes breakfasts), track entry on Sat & Sunday, all transfers to & from the airport and track on both days and insurance (assuming there are no special

circumstances to allow for with health issues...e.g. previous heart attacks, etc.). If the airlines don't hit me with any fuel surcharges, there might even be a few beers in it as a bonus too....
